## Study and group spaces

**Please note:** All of the campus library's study and training opportunities are free of charge (see [Library Regulations and Charges](#)).  
Library facilities may not be used for any commercial activities (e.g. private tutoring, exam preparations).

### Group & individual study spaces

There are rooms for group work and individual learning in the Campus Library.

You can use these rooms during the library's opening hours.

The rooms **cannot be reserved**.

- › An open area for group work is located in the southern wing of the basement, accessible via the south side staircase.
- › Six group work rooms with space for up to 8 people each are located in the [STUDYbox](#), accessible via the south side staircase.
- › Seven further group work rooms with space for 2 to 10 people are located on the second floor north.
- › An open area for group work is located in the second floor centre.
- › In the reading room you will find four single-user workstations for individual studying.
- › A room with 8 single-user workstations for individual studying is located on the first floor north, next to the training rooms.

### Computer workstations

You can use the following workstations in the Campus Library:

- › 20 [internet computers](#) in the reading room with a wide range of Open Source programmes.  
To [log in](#) please enter your library card number as the user ID and your password.
- › 15 [research computers](#) on all levels.  
These workstations can only be used for searching the catalogue of the ZHB (without access to full texts).
- › 1 workstation for [single-user data bases](#) in the reading room, near the internet workstations.
