E-Books

The Campus Library offers an ever growing number of e-books. Like all other materials, you can find them in the [catalogue](#).

This kind of electronic media is accessible from the internet workstations in the reading room and for members of both Flensburg universities using the WiFi on campus.

Outside the campus, only **members of the Flensburg universities** can access e-media. You have three options:

1. **Login in the Discovery system:** In the Discovery system, outside the campus network, you will see the display "Guest access - please log in!" at the top of the screen. Log in there with your network access data. You can also find more information under [Learning videos](#).
2. **Login at the provider via Shibboleth:** With many publishers and databases you can authenticate yourself via your university using Shibboleth.
3. **Access via VPN:** To gain access via VPN, you need a VPN client, which you can find on the website of the [Europa-Universität](#) or [Flensburg University of Applied Sciences](#).

Projekt Gutenberg/Project Gutenberg

The [Projekt Gutenberg](#) contains novels, short stories, novellas, dramas and poems by about 1,800 authors (as of January 2018) from antiquity to the 20th century in German. [Project Gutenberg](#) collects literary texts in English and includes over 53,000 freely accessible e-books and texts.

SpringerOpen

The [Open-Access-Portal](#) of the Springer publishing house currently contains more than 152 peer-reviewed journals and a small number of e-books from different subject areas (as of July 2014). All of these publications can be searched as full text editions.
