## The new ZHB search portal - all functions at a glance

- 1 Current search criteria: Optimize your search results with Limiter & other search options, without leaving your results list.
- 2 Filter the search results e.g. by resource type, topic, publication
- 3 Search history: Use previous search results and recombine them. You can be notified of new articles via RSS feed.
- 4 Updated information from the library catalogue: here you can see the current status of the media and can reserve them immediately (login to ZHB user account required).
- 5 Direct link to the full text (registration with your university access data may be necessary)
- 6 Current holdings: Shows you in which university holdings you are currently searching.
- 7 Here you can switch to the holdings of the other university. Physical media are included in both stocks.
- 8 Folder: Here you can find your saved records and search results.
- 9 User account: Here you can find all information about your ZHB user account.
- 10 Share: From this menu you can view notification, link export and folder options
- 11 Sort results: Sort results by relevance, publication date, authors or sources.
- 12 Preview and add to folder: Move the mouse over the symbol (mouse-over) to see a preview or add records to your folder.
- 13 Advanced search: Here you can search directly for media from an author, a specific title or a book or a journal via ISBN or ISSN
